In 2025, we'll follow the same successful formulae of the past: friendship, stories, campfires, and picnic tables.

Join us for the day, or stay for days!

WHEN: Arrive Tuesday, Tuesday June 03 (Monday OK too), depart Thursday June 05 (longer is possible).

WHERE: Nanton Lions Campground; turn east off Hwy #2 in the Town of Nanton (90km south of Calgary) onto Hwy #533, go ½ km. and turn left into campground. It is adjacent to the Nanton Golf Course.

CAMPING ARRANGEMENTS & COST: We have reserved spaces for 20 – 30 camper units (RV, trailers, tents) at a cost of \$25.00/night/unit; more space is available if numbers require it.

CAMPING FACILITIES: The campground is flat with good access on gravel roads. Campsites have fire pits but are otherwise un-serviced. There is a heated washroom with hot showers, and potable water. A camp kitchen/shelter with tables, wood stove and electricity is located within our group camping area. Google Nanton Lions Campground for details.

RESERVATIONS: Confirm your participation & reserve a site (ASAP) by contacting Alan Westhaver, (alan.westhaver@shaw.ca), fees will be collected on-site. To extend your stay, contact the campground.

MEALS: We will pool resources and order pizza from local restaurant for supper on Tuesday, bring something for pot-luck dinner on Wednesday, and we'll do a pancake breakfast on big grills provided by the Lions Club on Thursday morning. Snacks provided but contributions appreciated. Other meals are on your own. Camp kitchen is adjacent, with wood stove. Coffee pot on 24 hours!

MOTEL ACCOMMODATION: There is limited availability at Nanton (Rangeland Inn) or nearby at Claresholm (south 30 km.) at the Bluebird Motel or Lazy J, and at High River (25 km. north) Ramada, Heritage Inn, Super 8.
